

#### • Elizabeth Bardwell, J.D., Vice-Chairman

Ms. Bardwell is the Director of Conservation for Audubon New Mexico, the state office of the National Audubon Society. She has over 28 years of experience in the field of law and policy. Ms. Bardwell ran for Dona Ana County Commission, District 3, in November 2014. She has been a resident of New Mexico for over twenty years with her husband and two daughters. Ms. Bardwell has a Masters of Science in Biology from New Mexico State University (1999), a Juris Doctorate from the University of Oregon School of Law (1987) and a Bachelor of General Studies from University of Michigan (1980).

#### Juan A. Olvera – Executive Director

As Executive Director of the Mesilla Valley Public Housing Authority (MVPHA) – one of New Mexico's largest and high performing providers of affordable housing programs for low-income families, Mr. Olvera manages an annual operating budget of \$8.5 million that supports 252 public housing units, 40 Section 8 New Construction units, 661 affordable housing units, and 1,627 Housing Choice Vouchers (HCV) which provide housing to some 2,500 New Mexican. Mr. Olvera earned a Masters in Engineering Management/Industrial Engineering from Stanford University, and a Bachelor of Science in Chemical and Industrial Engineering from the Monterrey Institute of Technology, Mexico. His professional certifications include Public Housing Manager, Public Housing Executive Asset Manager, and Housing Choice Voucher Specialist.
