

Presenter: Mary Feldblum, Ph.D., "Health Security for New Mexicans"

Mary Feldblum is Executive Director for the Health Security for New Mexicans Campaign, a coalition of over 150 diverse organizations from around the state. Mary Feldblum has lived in New Mexico for thirty years. She works as a consultant in a variety of areas including social policy research, negotiations training, and public interest lobbying. She earned her Ph.D. in sociology from the New School for Social Research. From 1992-2002 she directed the Consumers Union New Mexico Health Care Project and was involved in patient protection, hospital sales, and health care reform issues.

**Voter Registration:** Voter registration closes on **October 11** and so it has been important to follow through with our plans.
