League of Women Voters Offers Voters Guides Before Election Day

LAS CRUCES---Still undecided on who to vote for? One way to help make those decisions is to review what the candidates have to say about themselves and their philosophies. The League of Women Voters of Southern New Mexico (LWVSNM) has printed a 2020 Voters Guide which contains information about the election and local candidates.

Thousands of guides were published on October 9 through the Las Cruces Bulletin and have been circulated throughout the county, said Co-President Kathy Brook. And, for the first time, the guide is also available in Spanish.

“A General Election is quite important and LWVSNM wanted to have greater outreach to voters who speak only Spanish,” Brook said. “With Camino Real Media’s assistance, we were able to get important voting information into the hands of more county residents.”

“The League prints these guides, and also has them online, in order to better inform voters prior to a major election,” added Co-President Eileen VanWie. “The majority of the local candidates answered questions that ranged from redistricting, to climate change, to health care, and more. All answers appear in the guide exactly as the candidates answered them. Supporting democracy and voters is important to our organization.”

The guide also features pros and cons on the two Constitutional Amendments, and information regarding three bond questions that are on the election ballot.
