VOTER INFORMATION

United States citizens who are 18 years of age on the day of an election and who have established a permanent residence in the State of New Mexico are eligible to register to vote in Doña Ana County. Registration must be done at least 28 days prior to an election, in person or by requesting a mail-in registration from the county Bureau of Elections. It is not necessary to register with a political party in order to vote. However, New Mexico is a “closed” primary state, meaning that you must be registered with a major political party (Democrat or Republican) in order to vote in that party’s primary election. Lack of a party designation does not prevent voters from participating in regular elections. Absentee and early voting is allowed for all voters, subject to specified time lines. Registration is permanent in New Mexico as long as you do not move or change your name or party affiliation. If you have not voted in several years, it is possible your name could be removed from the voter rolls. Voter registrations are canceled when the voter has moved from the county, has been convicted of a felony or has been declared mentally incompetent. US Executive Branch : Elected members of the Executive Branch consist of the President (who is also Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces) and the Vice President (who also serves as President of the Senate). They are elected as a team on a partisan basis for 4-year terms (limited to two terms) in even-numbered years. The President’s annual salary is \$400,000. The Vice President’s annual salary is \$230,700.

NM State Land Office: This office administers the State Lands Trust consisting of 9 million acres of surface estate and 13 million oil, gas and mineral estate held in trust and used to generate revenue for New Mexico's public schools, state institutions for higher learning and other public entities. NM Public Regulation Commission: The NMPRC regulates public utilities, telecommunications companies, and motor carriers operating in the state. It also administers the State Fire Marshal, the NM Firefighters Training Academy, and the Pipeline Safety Bureau. The three appointed commission members will serve staggered, six-year terms.

NOTE: The NM-PRC has been recently restructured by Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham in accordance with a Constitutional Amendment approved by voters in 2020 which transitioned the PRC from an elected body to an appointed one. The three appointed members will oversee the State's regulation of public utilities and New Mexico's transition to renewable energy. Legislation enacted in 2019 phases in requirements for public utilities to shift to carbon-free energy generation by 2045. She also signed an order creating a tribal advisory committee which is expected to consult with the PRC and provide input on its decisions.

NM LEGISLATIVE BRANCH : The New Mexico Legislature consists of 70 House and 42 Senate members, elected on a partisan basis by district in even-numbered years. Senators serve 4-year terms and Representatives serve 2-year terms. Legislators are unsalaried but receive a per diem of \$165 for each day they are in session (tied to the federal rate) plus mileage.

The Legislature convenes for regular sessions on the third Tuesday in January each year. It meets for 60 days in odd-numbered years and 30 days in even-numbered years. General information, along with session and committee schedules, is available from the Chief Clerks in either chamber and/or the Legislative Council.

District Court: The Third Judicial District Court is the state court of general jurisdiction covering Doña Ana County. It is based in Las Cruces. This Court has jurisdiction over criminal cases, domestic relations (divorce, child support & custody, domestic violence) probate, children's court (abuse & neglect, delinquency, adoptions) and civil cases (auto accidents, contract & property disputes, civil rights violations). Judicial assignments are shown below, with the Chief Judge also having administrative authority. After winning a 6-year partisan election, judges stand for nonpartisan retention. When vacancies occur, the Governor appoints District Judges who then must stand for election at the next general election.

SWCDs are authorized by the Soil and Water Conservation District Act (73-20-25 through 73-20-48 NMSA 1978) to perform a variety of functions. SWCDs conserve and develop the natural resources of the state, provide for flood control, preserve wildlife, and protect the tax base. This work promotes the health, safety, and general welfare of the people of New Mexico.

SWCDs coordinate assistance from all available sources — public and private, local, state and federal — in an effort to develop locally driven solutions to natural resource concerns. Forty-seven SWCDs encompass the majority of New Mexico's land area.

After elections and periodically, this publication, WHO'S WHO, is printed and posted on the LWVSNM website to enable voters to reach those whom they elected. The League is a nonpartisan organization that neither supports nor opposes political candidates or parties. Organized in 1920 to educate voters about the election process, it continues to provide that community service.
